

Game Rules

All players begin on square #1, "Start". Each player should roll the dice once to see who should begin first. The player with the highest number on the dice should start first. The first player should roll the dice and advance according to the number rolled on the dice. To help guide you in the correct direction, each square is numbered, and there are small arrows pointing up at the end of each row.

Arrow Squares

When a player lands on a square with an arrow leading out of it, the player must follow the direction of the arrow to the square where it ends. For example, if you land on square #38, you must go back to square #3.

Picture Squares

No action is required on picture squares without arrows leading out of them. These pictures can aid you in answering some of the questions, but not all questions have corresponding pictures. On spaces where pictures take up 2 squares (such as squares #2 and #3), these are considered two (2) separate squares, although no line is present through the picture to indicate this division.

Prophet Squares

When a player lands on a prophet square, the player gets to draw a question card.

Question Cards

There are 2 questions on each card, *Basic* and *Advanced*. Each time *before* the player draws a card, they must choose either a *Basic* or *Advanced* question. Once the player draws the card, the card is passed to another player for reading (if possible) from the category chosen. If the question is answered correctly, the player rolls the dice again. If the incorrect answer is given, it is the next player's turn. The answer to the question has been supplied below the cited scripture.*



Indicates that this prophet wrote a book in the Bible. No action is required.

The winner is the first player to reach square #100, "Finish". An exact number rolled on the dice is not required to land on Finish.

**You may choose instead to verify the answer supplied by looking it up in the Bible. The answer may vary slightly depending upon which version of the Bible you may be using. This product is an educational tool and is meant to encourage each person to discover the answers in the Bible for themselves either during the game or at a more convenient time. Additionally, for your convenience, listed below are the prophets and corresponding picture squares with the passages. We urge you to venture into the Bible to read these exciting stories.*
